Training Outcomes	After completing this program, participants will be able to: • Gain familiarity with the Bamboo Handicrafts sector: General introduction to various bamboo varieties and their features, identifying suitable species, and understanding the importance of age of bamboo. • Trained in Pre-Process Activities: Understanding the raw material requirement for both sliver making and ring making and the storage process of bamboo to preserve its freshness for a longer duration • Explain the process of bamboo sliver maker: Learn the best practices in cutting the bamboo poles, splitting them into sticks and gradually into slivers. Understanding the cleaning process to make slivers thinner and more pliable. Explore various methods to protect slivers against insects and fungi. • Explain and assess the quality aspects of the bamboo sliver: To Understand the basics of quality slivers by learning to identify defects and implementing effective rectification measures.
